The Course is designed to act as introduction to CP for personnel currently in the industry but not CP licensed. The Course is unashamedly Modelled on the SO6 (DPG) qualification of the same name.

SIA DS licence or currently engaged as part of in house security team .

The Course includes an EFA Certificate valid for 3 years and is soon to be accredited as a stand alone qualification.





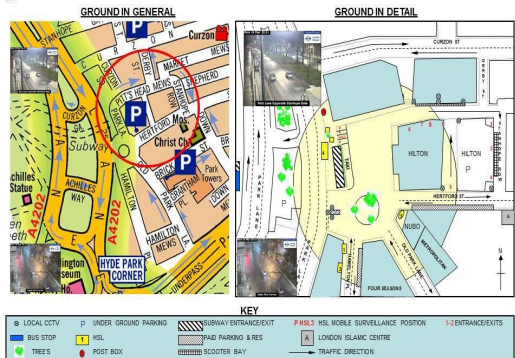

Ideally be older than 25 years

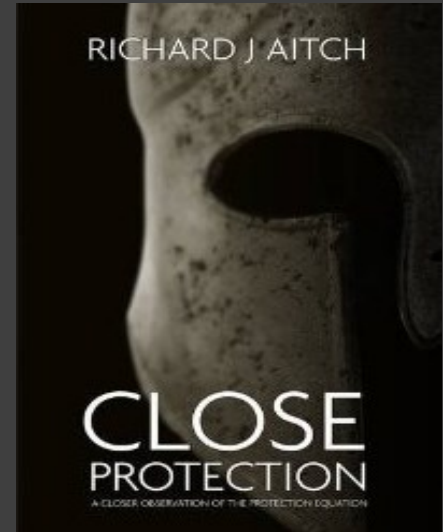
Be of good character— DBS records required for some tasks.
